## PALAZZO DEI PRIORI

One of the most majestic architectural expressions of medieval civilization in Italy (1293-1297), its construction continued until 1443. It is the seat of the Municipal Council and the home of the **National Gallery of Umbria** and of the town's two most important medieval guilds: the **Collegio del Cambio (Exchange Hall)** and the **Collegio della Mercanzia (Merchant's Hall)**. Outside, a broad staircase leads to the **Sala dei Notari (Hall of the Notaries)**, formerly the seat of meetings of the people and of the Notaries' Guild.

The National Gallery of Umbria displays its prestigious collection in a 4,000 sq.m. exhibition space that winds through 40 rooms.

It has one of the richest collections of art in Italy, almost 3000 works, including paintings, sculptures, ceramics, textiles and jewelry, that document seven centuries of Italian culture and history, by artists such as Duccio di Boninsegna, Gentile da Fabriano, Beato Angelico, Benozzo Gozzoli, Piero della Francesca, Pintoricchio, Perugino, Orazio Gentileschi, Pietro da Cortona and others.

**SALA DEI NOTARI (Hall of the Notaries)**

Built in 1293-1297, meetings of the people were held here. A majestic hall with a rectangular plan and a ceiling supported by eight mighty round arches. The frescoes on the walls represent legends, fables, maxims, biblical stories and the coats of arms of the Captains of the People and the Podestas, painted by local artists (late 13th cent.) and repainted and added to by Matteo Tassi in 1885.

Inside are the **Sala dei Legisti**, with carved stalls by Giampiero Zuccari (1615-1621); the **Sala dell'Udienza** with magnificent frescoes by Pietro Vannucci, better known as Perugino (1500), and carved and inlaid woodwork by Antonio da Mercatello and Domenico del Tasso; and the **San Giovanni Battista Chapel** with frescoes by Giannicola di Paolo, a student of Perugino (1513-1528).

## CATHEDRAL OF SAN LORENZO CHAPTER MUSEUM

The exhibit winds through 25 rooms on two floors, with archeological and architectural remains from the Etruscan-Roman and medieval periods. There are fine examples of illuminated manuscripts including evangeliaries and antiphonaries, paraments, Church silver and a faldstool from the 13th century. A number of excellent paintings are on display, including: the Sant'Onofrio altarpiece by Luca Signorelli, the "Pietà" by Bartolomeo Caporali, the triptych by Meo da Siena, and the altarpiece by Pompeo Cocchi.

## ROCCA PAOLINA

Entrances at Piazza Italia and Via Masi-Viale Indipendenza by means of an escalator system (since 1980) and from Porta Marzia (which incorporates part of the Etruscan gate)

**Opening hours** - daily: 8.00 am - 7.00 pm

*What can be seen is all that remains (it was mostly destroyed following the advent of the Unification of Italy) of the massive military fortress built by Pope Paul III in 1540-43, to the design of Antonio da Sangallo the Younger, over a populous medieval quarter (the Baglioni palaces). Once a symbol of papal rule, the Rocca has been restored inside and is now used for exhibitions and cultural events and houses the Rocca Paolina Museum Services Center (Tel. 075 5725778).*

*An interesting exhibition of documentary and audiovisual materials that allows one to trace the history of the Rocca from its origins and of its dialectical relationship with Perugia.*

L. Bernini, A. Algardi, A. Sacchi.*

***Gerardo Dottori Collection (1888-1977):** a large number of works by the Umbrian futurist master.*

The museum has a **Prehistoric Section** with Paleolithic, Neolithic, Bronze and Iron Age artifacts from central Italy (Metals Room); the **Etruscan and Roman Section** with Etruscan artifacts from various necropolises. Especially worthy of note: the **Cippus of Perugia**, with one of the most important inscriptions in the Etruscan language; the reconstruction of the **Cai Cutu** Etruscan tomb; the bronze statue of **Germanicus** (currently at Amelia); embossed sheet bronze from the **chariot of Castel San Mariano**; the extensive "**Orazio Antinori**" ethnological collection and the "**Giuseppe Bellucci**" collection of amulets and magical-religious objects (the museum collections are currently being re-organized).

This monumental well (3rd-2nd cent. BC) is an exceptional work of hydraulic engineering. Roughly 36 meters deep and fed by three veins of water, it was the town's main source of water in the Etruscan and Roman period.

### PIAZZA CAVALLOTTI ARCHEOLOGICAL AREA

This Roman mosaic of white and black tesserae goes back to the 2nd cent. AD. Discovered in 1875 on the site of the medieval church of Santa Elisabetta, it represents the myth of Orpheus and the Beasts, and was probably part of a public baths complex from Roman Perugia.

The Hypogeum (3rd cent. BC – 1st cent. AD) is part of the vast Palazzone Etruscan necropolis, with over 200 tombs dating from the 5th cent. BC to the Hellenistic age. Preserved inside are cinerary urns in travertine, terracotta, marble and sandstone. A magnificent, steep access corridor (dromos) leads to the burial chamber of Arunte and Lars Volumnio; the tomb has a plan similar to the structure of a Roman-Italic house, with rooms around a central atrium.

### SAN MANNO HYPOGEUM

The tomb (3rd-2nd cent. BC), found in a crypt in the small Church of San Manno, is entirely lined with travertine blocks, and has a barrel vault and a 5-meter long inscription with the names of the members of the Etruscan Precu family. It has recently been restored.

### CATHEDRAL OF SAN LORENZO

*Built in the 15th century, it has Baroque doors and inside there are frescoes from the 1700s. Standing out among the many art works are the reliquary of the Holy Ring and the canvas of the Deposition by Federico Barocci (1569). In the sacristy is a magnificent painting cycle by Pandolfi (1573-76).*

### CHURCH OF SANT'ERCOLANO

*Dedicated to the patron saint of Perugia martyred in 548 AD, it has an unusual tower shape, originally (14th cent.) with two floors. The exterior stairs were redone in the 1600s, and the interior is sumptuously decorated in the Baroque style.*

### BASILICA OF SAN DOMENICO

*The largest church in town and in Umbria, built in various stages and rebuilt by Maderno in 1632. Inside are the elegant tomb of Pope Benedict XI (14th cent.), the impressive 23-meter-high stained glass windows (1411), the choir (16th cent.) and the organ (17th cent.).*

*The unusual, vast attics can be visited by request.*

### BASILICA OF SAN PIETRO

*The decoration in the Basilica is incredibly sumptuous, from the Roman capitals and columns, to the gilt ceiling, the excellent paintings in the three naves and the sacristy, a veritable museum of painting and sculpture, from Perugino to Wicar, Guido Reni and Algardi. The large baldachin and wooden choir by the Lombard school are exceptionally fine. Underneath the apse is a round, early medieval crypt, with an ambulatory and painted walls.*

*Remaining from the original 14th-century structure are the pink and white stone façade with a Gothic portal and rose window, and the remains of frescoes. The attractive cloister is from 1376.*

### CHURCH OF THE GESU'

*Built in the 16th century, the richly decorated interior has a central nave and two side aisles. The façade was renovated in 1934. In the vault, frescoes by Giovanni Andrea Carloni of Genoa depict the stories of Joshua (1656). The church stands over three oratories, set one on top of the other, like a tower: according to the social hierarchy, the highest is the Oratory of the Congregation of Nobles, next that of the Artists and at the bottom that of the Colonists.*

Over the high altar is an important canvas by Pietro da Cortona, the Immaculate Conception (1662).*

### ORATORY OF SANTA CECILIA

Via Fratti (crosses Via della Stella) – annexed to San Filippo Neri

*Built in 1687-90, used also as a hall for music, in following with the rule of the Oratorians. The Oratory has a magnificent Baroque interior with a central Greek cross plan, two rows of stalls and a dome roof. After being renovated and restored in 2001, it has been used for concerts and cultural events.*

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#### ORATORY OF SAN FRANCESCO DEI NOBILI

*One of the most interesting examples of the early Baroque in Perugia, the oratory has fine stucco work in the vestibule by the French artist Jean Regnaud de Champagne and, inside, the most important group of paintings by G. A. Scaramuccia (1611-1627), a gilt wooden coffered ceiling, excellent wooden carvings and chairs by Zuccari. In the sacristy is a canvas of the Flagellation (1480), attributed to Pietro Galeotto.*

#### ORATORIES OF SAN BERNARDINO AND SANT'ANDREA DELLA GIUSTIZIA

*The complex, which goes back to the mid-15th cent., has an elegant polychrome façade with superb bas-reliefs, a masterpiece by Agostino di Duccio (1457-61), the finest example of Renaissance art in Perugia. The oratory behind it was built in the 1500s and redone in the 1700s, and has a gilt ceiling and admirable stucco work and paintings.*
