

1. Gardens in Piazza Italia



The square, a symbol of the post-unification city, built after the demolition of the Rocca Paolina Fortress, is decorated with flower beds, and centuries-old Atlas cedars and Norway spruces, which stand about 25 meters high.

2. Carducci Gardens



Dedicated to the poet who composed the ode *Canto dell'amore*, which was inspired by the view that can be enjoyed from here, on a visit to Perugia, in 1877. In the gardens overlooked by age-old holm-oaks, you can find the bronze busts dedicated to Carducci and other famous artists and figures from Perugia, such as Pinturicchio, Alessi, Calderini and Antinori. In the centre is the monument to Pietro Perugino by Enrico Quattrini (1923). Pines stand out on the Carducci viewpoint.

3. Frontone Gardens



Building was started in 1707 for the summer meetings of the Accademia degli Arcadi. The name comes from the front of the triumphal arch, which closes the amphitheatre that was built following the design of Baldassarre Orsini (1791). Parallel lines of monumental holm-oaks were added in the 18th century.

4. Orto medievale (Medieval Garden)



Connected to the Benedictine complex of San Pietro and the faculty of Agriculture, it contains the species that were grown in the Middle Ages (open only on weekdays).

5. Botanical garden

The garden, which is connected to the faculty of Agriculture, outside Porta San Costanzo, supports research and carries out educational activities, and has a rich variety of about 3000 species.



6. ParK of Sant'Anna



Set in the old gorge of the ditch of Sant'Anna, it covers an area of approximately 30,000 square metres. It has rich vegetation, with various types of willows and poplars that once belonged to the riparian strip of the ditch and fruit trees from previous orchards.

7. Green area of Santa Giuliana



It covers an area of approximately 3 hectares, which was used as an arms square and later as a cattle market, near the monastery and church of Santa Giuliana. It includes the old football stadium. Of particular note among the tree varieties are hornbeams, downy oaks, holm-oaks, cypresses, maples and elms.

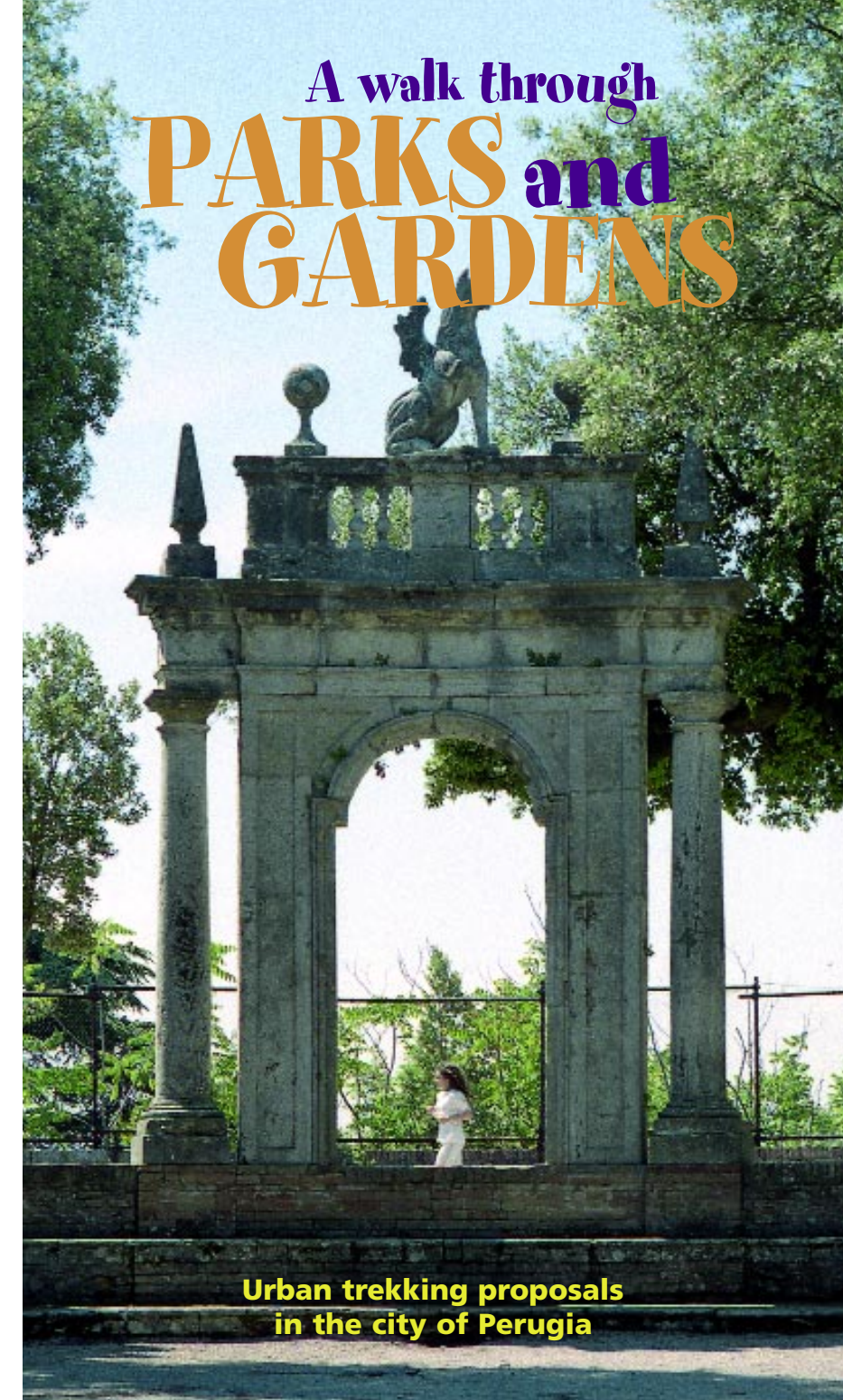
